Each year, the Chapter Executive Committee, District Chairman, Council President, Scout Executive, or members of the professional staff may nominate adult leaders, (21 years of age or older), for membership in the Order of the Arrow to the Chapter Adult Selection Committee, composed of the Chapter Adviser, chairman of the district committee on which the Chapter Adviser serves, and the District Scout Executive. Recommendations of the Chapter Adult Selection Committee will be forwarded to the Lodge Adult Selection Committee, composed of the Lodge Adviser, the council camping chairman, and the Lodge Staff Adviser. Notification and/or call-out of the District Recommended adult candidates are not permitted without the approval of the Lodge Adult Selection Committee. All of the following requirements should be fulfilled. The camping requirement may be waived at the discretion of the Lodge Adviser and the Council Scout Executive. NO OTHER WAIVERS are permitted.

- (1) Selection of adults into the OA is based upon the ability of the adult to perform necessary functions to help the Order fulfill its purpose, and NOT for recognition of service, including current or prior achievement and positions.
- (2) The adult scouter being recommended will be an asset to the Order due to **DEMONSTRATED SKILLS AND ABILITIES THAT FULFILL THE PURPOSE OF THE ORDER**. This individual being recommended is qualified and willing to serve in the following capacities at either the Chapter or Lodge level.

- (3) The camping requirement is being fulfilled within the two years prior to recommendation date. The adult scouter must have at least **15 days and nights of camping** under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America, which includes **six consecutive days and five nights of long term camping** (Note: Cub Scout, Webelos, and family camping do not qualify); **short term camping must total ten nights**, excess long-term camping will not count towards the short-term camping nights.
